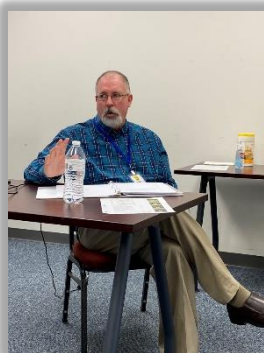

- Pray for more Good News Clubs to start in 2022.

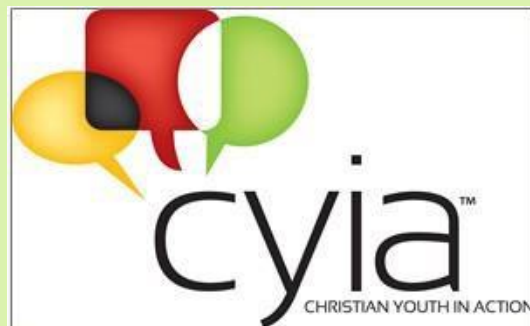
